Abstract: This study adopts the Theory of Planned Behavior (TPB) framework to examine the effect of the government-initiated Entrepreneurship Student Program (ESP) on the entrepreneurial intentions and behavior of students. Aside from ESP, this study also includes market information adequacy along with standard psychological components of TPB (attitude, subjective norms, and perceived behavioral control) as predictor variables. Partial Least Squares - Structural Equation Modeling (PLS-SEM) technique is employed to analyze the data collected from 208 university students in Semarang, Indonesia. This study finds that ESP and the adequacy of market information directly influence the entrepreneurial behavior of students in Indonesia, while the influence of attitudes and perceived behavior control is mediated by entrepreneurial intention. One of the implications of this study is that ESP can be considered effective in preparing and facilitating entrepreneurship among university students, therefore the government should consider increasing the reach of ESP to cover the majority of universities in Indonesia.
