### Comments from the editors and reviewers:

#### -Reviewer 1

This study used remote sensing and machine learning techniques to investigate the impact of the coastal industrialization policy in Indonesia. This is an interesting topic and the results have some implications for industrialization policy and land use policy. However, the express of this study is poor, I suggest a major revision before it could be published in Applied Geography. The detail comments are list as follows:

1 Literature Review. Please list more references which are relevant to the topic. Furthermore, the citing papers are a little old, please select some newest studies. Thirdly, the citing format may be wrong.

2 Figure 1 should provided more information such as existing carbon discharge, industrialization degree, and so on.

3 Figure 3 is misty.

4 Result analysis is not thorough. In this section the authors list some LULC change results and Blue Carbon Storage change results, I can't find enough explanation and demonstration of these results.

5 The structure of the manuscript is confused. What is the relationship between results analysis and discussion?

6 There are too much long sentences which are very difficult to understand.

7 The innovation of this study should be explained more clearly.

#### -Reviewer 2

- The article discusses an important topic which needs to be investigated and explored.

I believe the article is well-explained generally. I only have 3 main comments.

1. The article uses satellite imagery data from 2015 and 2019. I understand you are trying to look at the differences, however, I wonder if it is possible to include data for each year between 2015 to 2019 which would mean 2016, 2017, and 2018 as well. On the same note, I tried finding the date for which the photos were captured. I could not find them. Ideally, the pictures should be from the same time period. I understand the Land use might not be an issue for this, but Land cover might change back and forth between different seasons. I think your article could benefit from additional data and make better recommendations

2. You are claiming percentage of the BCS due to industrialization of the area and presenting data for each year between 2015 to 2019. If you can present the BCS data for each year, it'd be easier to see the contribution of the industry towards diminishing.

3. your conclusion is rather short, I'd really like to see some recommendation as a result of your research.

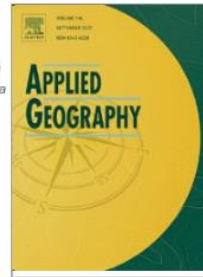
