- Jurnal *The International Journal of Climate Change: Impacts and Responses* memiliki unsur unsur yang dinilai lengkap, mulai dari introduction sampai conclusion dan references dan dibagian akhir disampaikan pula About the Authors.
- Ruang lingkup artikel ini tidak secara langsung sesuai dengan bidang penulis yakni oceanografi, tetapi artikel ini tentang fungsi padang lamun. Pembahasan hasil penelitian dinilai cukup mendalam karena didukung data biomasa lamun dan carbon yang didukung dengan 37 pustaka.
- Artikel ini memberikan data dan informasi yang dinilai mencukupi. Metodologi yang digunakan merupakan metode standard yakni survey untuk melihat kerapatan lamun, juga analisis laboratorium untuk melihat biomasa, carbon, termasuk carbon di sedimen, dll.
