Reviewer #2: - Even though the authors stated that the title has been changed to "Mosque Design Strategy for Energy and Water Saving", however, in the manuscript, the title is still the same as "Design Strategy for Making Sustainable Mosque". Also, in abstract, the authors still stated "this paper aimed to suggest a design strategy for making a sustainable mosque". The authors must go through the manuscript so that it is inline with the change in the title.

- I think in Section 9, "Design guideline synthesis" can be changed into Case Study or related-title to show the connection between this section with section 2.

- I would argue that study case and simulation is a different thing. In a simulation, the authors deal with an artificial mosque, generating "the best" mosque with some predefined parameters. However, in a case study, the authors try to describe a real mosque and analyse/criticize the design and compare with the predefined parameters.

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
