- Typos from the template are still present in the text.
- At the beginning of the paper, before the Introduction section, a Nomenclature section, not numbered, should be added with a list, in alphabetic order, of all the used distinct symbols/acronyms and their meaning.
- At the end of the Introduction add a paragraph on how the rest of the paper is organized and developed, typically a summary on the rest.
