Comments from the Editors and Reviewers:

Re: MS. No. GPOM-2022-6612

Title: Magnetic-silica core/shell functionalized with polyaniline for antibacterial and anticandidal treatment. Authors: Ayu Sri Wahyuni, Damar Nurwahyu Bima, Choiril Azmiyawati, Adi Darmawan.

Although the antibacterial and anticandidal properties are important and interesting for readers, the good and justice

results have not been obtained. As they have reported "The PANI-SMc showed a lower inhibitory zone than PANI alone". And it is more important, the antibacterial and anticandidal properties have already been reported for PANI and its composites before. In the current article the products are not well characterized especially and the authors must report TEM results for better characterization and providing core-shell. However, the paper is well written and English is good. Recommend a major revision and authors must revise it due to the following comments:

- 1. There are several similar reports from Magnetic-silica core/shell functionalized with polyaniline for antibacterial and anticandidal treatment. Authors must clearly explain originality. Synthesis or/and application is new??!!
- 2. In 2.1. Materials, section authors must determine where got or purchased natural magnetite powder?!
- 3. "PANI/silica-coated magnetite composite preparation has been reported previously [8]." This reference explains it from TEOS?!!

 But ref 34 is from sodium silicate (Na2SiO3)??!!
- 4. in 2.2. Fabrication of silica-coated magnetite with Na2SiO3 section

"The coating process of magnetite was conducted by mixing in a 1:20 ratio of magnetite powder and 10% sodium silicate solution. Three molar hydrochloric acid solutions were added dropwise until the mixture reached the target pH (3-9)."

- 4-a) amounts of materials must clearly explain (initial amounts of silica-coated magnetite?).
- 4-b) what is initial pH?! Which with increase of HCl has raised to 9??
- 5- In next section, polymerization of aniline in the presence of SMc, HCl has been added. Then, pH control of prior section is meaningless?! Unless structure SMc have changed that it must be prove.
- 6. in IR section "PANI has a characteristic band at 1583 cm-1, corresponds to the -C=C- stretching vibrations of quinoid Page 1 (N=Q=N), and shifted to 1618-1643 cm-1 in PANI-SMc, indicating imine nitrogen is more involved in the interaction".

It don't seem description 1618-1643 cm-1 be true?!

- 7. in "Ammonium persulfate (APS) 0.25 mol L-1 was added to previous solutions in an equal volume.? Careful amounts?!
- 8. in "PANI spectra show two characteristic bands at 1583 cm-1 and 1479 cm-1 ascribed to the -C=C and -C=N-stretching vibrations of quinoid (N=Q=N) X? and the benzoid (N=B=N) rings, respectively,"
- 9. in XRD section "indicating the formation of a low-level crystalline phase in the polymer"
- 9-a) What is a low-level crystalline phase??!!

Morphology is amorphous.

- 9-b) core-shall morphology must be proved by TEM and so on.
- 9-c) since there is not any peak from Fe3O4 phase in XRD thus it don't seem VSM results be true?! In fact magnetic property must be very low?!

If this sentence be true "This finding confirms that the PANI layer had covered the surface of SMc and did not affect the structure of the SMc embedded in the PANI layer" in XRD must be observed peaks of Fe3O4 phase.

- 10. What is meaning "Microbial susceptibility to PANI is species dependent"??
- 11. in "This phenomenon can be explained by (a) the conducting PANI releases the acidic dopant ions, which react with the bacteria cell wall/membrane and then kills it, or (b) both the bacteria and PANI have opposite charge, causing electrostatic adhesion between them so the bacterial cell wall/membrane lysis and leading to the death. This claim must be proved.
- 12. Unfortunately, "The PANI-SMc showed a lower inhibitory zone than PANI alone" shows that final results of biological tests is worthless?!
- 13. How is effect of pH?! In "The PANI-SMc showed a lower inhibitory zone than PANI alone Fig. 8 shows the effect of pH PANI-SMc on the susceptibility of the microorganisms." It needs proof and explanation.
- 14. in "Based on variations in surface magnetite characteristics, the susceptibility of composites is possibly associated with relative electrostatic repulsive action."

 It needs proof and explanation.
- 15. Other techniques is need for more characterization such as conductivity, electrochemical impedance spectroscopy (EIS) analysis.

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


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
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
