1. General Comment: Interesting and very rare case, concise and clear but need additional data to clarify some issues
2. Abstract: Quite clear and understandable
3. Introduction: Please focus on double culprit lesion, add data specifically clinical outcome and mortality rate among them
4. Methodology: Important data are available
5. Results:

In case presentation, some issues to be clarified:

- a. The authors wrote that all patients suffered from acute heart failure, but only patient B that well described suffering AHF; others were unclear
- b. Patient A was reported well during PPCI and 2 days after PPCI, but suddenly deteriorated and death. Any additional data that could explain the cause of deterioration?
- c. Any information about the use of GP IIB/IIIA during primary PCI related with thrombus burden of each patient?
6. Discussion:
 - a. Please stated clearly about the definition of degree of coronary occlusion related with the number of coronary arteries involved in
