2. Tentang ruang lingkup dan kedalaman pembahasan:

Pembahasan isi penelitian cukup dalam namun didominasi tabel-tabel hasil uji statistic. Post power syndrome kelompok cluster Jepara dan Semarang hasilnya cukup tinggi namun belum ada pembahasan lebih lanjut mengenai argumen ataupun pandangan secara teoritis dan hasil riset sebelumnya mengapa hasil tersebut cukup berbeda dengan kelompok di tempat lainnya.

3. Kecukupan dan kemutakhiran data/informasi dan metodologi:

Daftar pustaka dalam artikel ini memuat 22 referensi, dan 80% diantaranya merupakan terbitan 10 tahun terakhir. Dari perspektif jumlah, 22 referensi yang digunakan sebagai sumber pustaka tergolong cukup untuk mendukung sebuah artikel yang komprehensif.

4. Kelengkapan unsur kualitas penerbit:

Kualitas terbitan prosiding cukup memadai yaitu diterbitkan oleh Universitas Jenderal Soedirman. Kualitas cetak juga cukup memadai.

5. Indikasi plagiasi:

Orisinalitas artikel ini tergolong cukup baik, yang ditunjukkan dengan hasil Turnitin Similarity Index sebesar 17%. Hal ini juga memberikan gambaran bahwa tidak terdapat tanda plagiarisme dalam artikel ini.

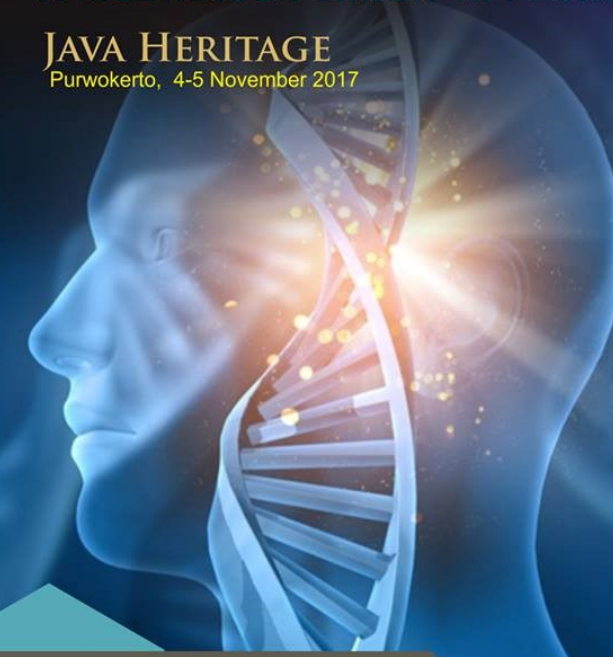
