

The number of Indonesian Migrant Workers (TKI) across the world reached almost seven million people in 2016. Migration brings positive impacts on both economic and social aspects of their lives. It also brings the same life for their families and countries of destination and origin. One of the main destination countries is Hongkong. This study aims to identify and map the social economic conditions and to analyze the welfare of TKI in Hongkong. The study uses sequential mixed method. It is the combination of quantitative and qualitative methods. The analytical tool consists of the spatial analysis of Geographic Information Systems (GIS), regression and phenomenology analysis. GIS analysis is in the form of mapping of the social economic conditions of migrant workers in Hongkong based on gathering places with the crowded theory. The data is divided into three main themes. The first is the origin of migrant workers- province, town or village of origin- and the type of work in Indonesia. The second includes education, experience, age, and the number of family members. The last is the cost of living. The regression analysis uses remittance sent to Indonesia as a proxy for the welfare of migrant workers as the dependent variable. The results show that the remittance are significantly influenced by income, Education level, the number of family members, planned retirement age and the cost of living, but age, experience, and departure cost, show no effect on remittance. Both results are explained qualitatively by phenomenological analysis. The results show that there are some non-economic variables that affect the level of welfare among migrant workers. Variables such as culture, geography, non-formal education, family situation and future expectations shown by the plan after retirement influence perception on improving the welfare of migrant workers. © Serials Publications Pvt. Transactional and Psychological Concerns of all Parties involved in Opaque Hotel Room Distribution

Purpose: The purpose of this paper is to understand various challenges faced by the hotel suppliers, intermediates and consumers while transacting for hotel room distribution through opaque websites. Further the paper tries to identify possible mitigation strategies they could adopt.

Design/methodology/approach: The paper outlines various transactional and psychological concerns of all the parties involved in opaque hotel room distribution and explores current and future mitigation strategies adopted by them.

Findings: The research identify several key challenges and suggest various possible mitigation strategies they could adopt more pertinent to transactional and behavioral concerns of the hotel room suppliers, intermediates and consumers face while transacting for opaque hotel rooms.

Research limitations/implications: The descriptive research on the behavioral aspects the three parties involved i.e. suppliers, intermediates and consumers while transacting for hotel room sales may be generalized to all of them but individuals may have very different attitude, interest, and opinion about distribution of hotel room through opaque websites.

Practical implications: Hotel operators, hotel opaque website companies can considers and evaluate various consumer behavioral hurdles discussed in the article can help them to formulate appropriate strategies to overcome them and win confidence of consumer and gain their market share.

Originality/value: The paper provides insight of various transactional challenges faced by hotel suppliers, opaque intermediates and consumers while transacting through opaque websites. The study could provide valuable inputs to hotel operators, opaque intermediates to formulate strategies to refine and strengthen their electronic distribution of hotel rooms.

Corporate Governance in Family Business: Evidence from Saudi Arabia

Abstract: The paper investigates the corporate governance practice in the family owned business in Saudi Arabia. It has two objectives: first, to contribute to the scarce body of literature by exploring the corporate governance of the family firms in Saudi; secondly, to place the corporate governance of Saudi family firms within the international debate of the best practices of corporate governance mechanisms using the OECD principles. This was an exploratory and analytically descriptive study seeking to discover and unravel the process of corporate governance mechanisms in family business. The dominant research strategy and design of the study were largely quantitative. The primary data were collected by questionnaire and interviewing the purposively selected samples; respondents of founders and successors of Saudi-based family businesses which had minimum five years operation when this research was conducted. Moreover company's documentation and extended library research were used as secondary data as well as for validity and reliability checks. The results disclose the potential strengths and weaknesses of the existing corporate governance framework of the family-owned firms in Saudi and may have significant implications for other Gulf Corporation Countries. The Saudi family-owned firms are the backbone of the Saudi economy and are active in traditional family governance but the challenge for them is to move away from conservative, traditional, weak corporate governance mechanisms and become significant players in high value, mixed Islamic and International corporate governance standards and principles. This is an important managerial and public policy concern, given that they are the backbone of the Saudi economy. Although the literature on corporate governance on developed country family-listed companies is rich, only a few studies have examined family owned, non-listed corporate governance in the context of Middle East countries. Moreover, the study integrates the international commended governance principles developed by OECD, which was not done previously on Saudi Arabia.
