Reviewer A:

Dear author,

the paper deals with an interesting topic, that is the impacts of revitalization of traditional markets in order to support and develop strategies for their sustainability.

However, the paper – although interesting to read - suffers from some major weaknesses and could be greatly improved. In particular:

- There is the need to restructure the abstract to make it more effective. It is not necessary to go into as much detail about the case studies, but rather to provide a framework for the topic of the paper and highlight its objectives, methodology, and results. The recommended structure could be the following: Purpose; Design/methodology/approach; Findings; Practical implications; Originality/value.
- There is a need to reorganize the paper with an introductory paragraph that frames the issue within the international scientific debate. For example, the conclusions refer to the 17 SDGs, but these goals (and in general UN documents such as the 2030 Agenda and the New Urban Agenda) appear for the first time at the end of the paper. The introduction should start by contextualizing the topic of the paper in light, for example, of these documents.
- At the end of the first paragraph, the thesis and the objective of the paper should be highlighted. Furthermore, it is also suggested to add, at the end of the first section, a brief summary about the structure of the paper and the content of the following paragraphs in order to "prepare" the readers and thus make the reading easier.
- A second paragraph should be added explicitly referring to the state of the art on the subject dealt with in the paper. Then, starting from the second paragraph, the methodology and the case study can be introduced. The case study should have the function of supporting the thesis expressed in the previous paragraphs.
- The paragraph on methodology certainly needs to be integrated with more detail regarding the entire evaluation process. More information are required regarding the interview (structure of the questionnaire, sample of interviewees, how the interview has been conducted, etc.).
- The paper is not formatted according to the journal layout.
- It is recommended to have the text reviewed by a native speaker as there are some language mistakes.
- The formatting should be reviewed as there are some typographical errors (e.g., double spaces).

The paper needs to be revised after modifications in order to be published.

Recommendation: Resubmit for Review

Reviewer B:

The paper presents a research very stimulating. The conservation/revitalization of the cultural heritage is a topic which now affects different research fields.

Before proceeding with revisions, it is necessary to format the paper. The manuscript must be formatted according to the Aestimum template guidelines, available on the website.
(<https://oaj.fupress.net/index.php/ceset/about/submissions>).

The contribution, subdivided into paragraphs and sub-paragraphs, numbered progressively according to ordinal classification, must not normally exceed 25 folders, including abstract, references list, tables, and images.

All publications cited in the text should be presented in a list of references following the text of the manuscript. In the text refer to the author's name (without initial) and year of publication with the number of pages (in the case of citations), according to the Aestimum template guidelines.

Therefore, the paragraphs of the paper should be numbered according to the guidelines.

Introduction section

1. The introduction could use more references to the rich and variable literature on the sustainable reuse of cultural heritage related to the importance of the cultural aspects for the sustainable development.
2. It might be interesting to insert more scientific literature about the "sustainable development goals", indicating which goals to meet in order to strengthen the research proposal able to optimize the sustainable projects of the two markets.
3. Where is written: "Many studies have discussed the impact of physical changes", can you add more bibliographic references and argue them in more detail?

Among these studies, are there any best practices that demonstrate the success of the revitalization of the historic markets? If yes, they should be described.

Methodology

1. Describe more clearly how the interviews with users in the two markets were conducted. If a questionnaire was submitted, and how it was structured. If questions were asked on the spot, please indicate how the answers were collected and how the data were processed.

Traditional Market Post Revitalization

1. This is a paragraph that explains very well the interventions that have been done for Bulu Market and Peterongan Market. After this description it could be interesting to do a Swot analysis of the two revitalization projects, identifying their strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats. In this way it is possible to strengthen the proposal that is made in the section "Market Sustainability after Revitalization", which defines some strategies to improve the revitalization interventions of the two markets.

Among Swot Analysis results, could be emphasize that a good historical building project he depends on, not only on its physical aspects but also on non-physical aspects.

1. If possible, indicate the costs of the projects incurred for the revitalization interventions of the two markets.

Market Sustainability after Revitalization

In this paragraph, is define a proposal is made to improve the revitalization projects of the two historic markets. It is necessary that this proposal to be better structured and strengthened.

To build the sustainable proposal, should recall the results obtained from the experiments carried out in the preceding paragraphs, with the aim to define an introduction to your revitalization proposal. To do this, it could be interesting to reclaim the following points:

- Include more literature on the concept of sustainable development, to provide a clear advance in current knowledge;
- Include more literature on the concept of the role of cultural aspects for sustainable development;
- I advise the authors to mention in the text to which Sustainable Development Goal proposed by the United Nations in the 2030 Agenda the contribution refers to;
- Mention the good practices of successful revitalization projects, highlighting what were the actions that led to the success of the intervention;
- Highlight the results of the questionnaire, which identify what are the priorities recognized by sellers and buyers to improve the market fruition;
- Include more literature about the role of stakeholder's participation in the historic building's revitalization projects;
- Highlight the results of the Swot Analysis.

Finalized the introduction of the proposal for a sustainable market after revitalization, it is possible to describe all the project solutions as a concrete "action plan", that the government can consult to improve the use of the two markets.

Conclusion

Conclusions should be improved based on the considerations/integrations made in the previous paragraphs.

Reviewer A:

The authors have certainly improved the paper and addressed (partially) the recommendations made, but further integrations (already partly requested in the previous review report) are needed before the paper can be published.

- One paragraph is missing between the introduction and the methodology. "A second paragraph should be added explicitly referring to the state of the art on the subject dealt with in the paper. Then, starting from the second paragraph, the methodology and the case study can be introduced. The case study should have the function of supporting the thesis expressed in the previous paragraphs". The introduction paragraph is only intended to frame the issue, which then needs to be discussed in more detail in subsequent paragraphs.
- The paragraph on methodology still needs to be integrated with more detail regarding the entire evaluation process. More information are required regarding the interview (structure of the questionnaire, sample of interviewees, how the interview has been conducted, etc.). For example: how was the questionnaire submitted? Face-to-face? How many responses were obtained? etc.

It would be better to highlight the changes made (i.e. with a different color) so that they can be easily identified.

Recommendation: Revisions Required

Reviewer B:

The authors have improved the text according to the revisions of the previous reference. For this reason, the paper might be published. There are only a few inaccuracies in the formatting of the paper.

Images, tables and mathematical equations must be reported at the end of the manuscript.

The authors have to indicate the position in which images, tables and mathematical equations must be inserted, including the related captions written in the same format as the body of the text.

Images must be uploaded also as separated files in the step 4 of the submission process into "Upload supplementary file". Images must respect the format of the Journal page (mm 170 × 240). Images must be added in colour, but will be published in black-and-white in the print version. It is, therefore, necessary that in their transformation from colour to black-and-white the information reported in them are legible. The images require the TIFF or EPS format (with a resolution of 300 DPI).

It is necessary to control the references in the text and in the references section. All publications cited in the text should be presented in a list of references following the text of the manuscript. In the text refer to the author's name (without initial) and year of publication with the number of pages (in the case of citations), according to the following examples:

Reviewer A:

Dear authors,

the paper has been modified and improved according to some recommendations. However, other improvements can be made.

- As done in the introduction paragraph, also in the abstract the topic should be contextualized in light of the SDGs.
- As previously suggested, the introduction (which contextualizes the issue addressed) and the state of the art (other studies that have addressed the same issue) should be separated into two different paragraphs.
- The structure of the questionnaire and its submission need to be more thorough and described in a scientific way giving information to better understand the participatory process. What is the time frame in which you interviewed the sample? Were they structured with open-ended or multiple-choice questions? How were the results analyzed? etc. These are just a few examples of missing information.
- The description of the questions needs to be more detailed. *"The questions asked were focused on accessibility, condition of goods, the reputation of the market, shop's atmosphere, in-store services, public facilities, price of goods, and shopping safety"*. This description is too general. "Shop's atmosphere," what do you mean? "In-store services" do you mean what services are there or the quality of the services? "Public facilities" do you mean if there are public facilities or their quality or use? These are just a few examples. The questionnaire is not clear. If you feel it is appropriate, you can add it as an attachment.
- The paragraph of results from interviews needs improvement. It seems more like a description of an external observer than the deduction of results from an evaluation process (analysis of questionnaire results). The results should refer to the responses received (How respondents many highlighted a certain aspect? How many have a certain perception? etc.).
