- 4. The article can be enhanced by describing the practical implications of your findings for small-scale logistics companies in Semarang or even for companies more broadly. How can these findings help companies improve their performance?
- 5. Consider expanding the keywords to include more specific terms that better reflect the research context. This will help readers searching for similar research to find your article more easily.

- In the conclusion or discussion section, expand on the practical applications of your research. How can the insights gained from this study be applied by logistics companies to improve their supply chain performance? Provide actionable recommendations for practitioners.
