Reviewer reports:

Reviewer #2: The article is well studied and presented. Graphical Abstract are meaning full and good. But I find no useful information or findings in the manuscript suitable to the journal standards nor to the researchers reading it. I suggest the authors to statistic research journals instead of specialty journals

Reviewer #3: The paper is professionally written and well organized. The idea is crucial and certainly novel in the field of Forensic Odontology. The work objective is clear, the method and results supported the purpose, and references were properly cited, respecting the journal format. The research presents very interesting insights on the progress and emerging trends in research related to Dental Age Estimation. However, some concerns still to be addressed:

- * Beginning of the research on Dental Age Estimation?? Was it in 1964 as mentioned in abstract and table 1, no work was done to estimate age from teeth before that date?
- * Keywords: add forensic odontology, why the authors did not use "forensic odontology" in the search strategy?
- * It would be better to add a Diagrammatic representation of the data generating process/Flow diagram of data filtering.
- * How many researchers conducted the search through Scopus for the search process? When the search was conducted on the same day or multiple sessions, how did the authors avoid bias in the search process? Why was Web of Science (WoS) not selected as the database of DAE?
- * The Methodology section should be organized using subtitles for more clarification. Were the Visualization networks using VOSviewer applied?
