I reviewed the paper titled "Kidney transplantation in Indonesia: an update" by Tommy Supit et al. from Semarang, Indonesia. This is a single-center study of live-related kidney transplantation. Indonesia is a very populous country ... with a handful of kidney transplantations.

Why was the mortality rate so high in the short term (25%)? Each case has to be described.

Immunosuppression needs to be detailed: induction therapy? Which maintenance immunosuppression? What is the eGFR at 1, 2, and 3 years posttransplantation? What type of infectious complication were observed?

What are the limitations of increasing the number of live-kidney transplants?

Comments to the Author

In this manuscript, authors describe the current status of kidney transplantation in Indonesia which is still in its infancy. The authors discuss ways to increase transplantation including insurance coverage, training more transplant professionals, public education about living and deceased kidney donation. etc. Over all article is written well.

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I have the following comments:

1. On page 2, mortality is described as 75%, please correct. 5 out of 20 (25%) death is still extremely high for kidney transplantation. This highlights the need for more training and expertise.
2. Similarly 3 year graft survival of 50% is extremely low
3. There should be some discussion on kind of immunosuppression used and about post op care
4. Discussion should also include the need for a national data base for future analysis.

Reviewer: 3

Comments to the Author

The authors present the transplantation performance in Indonesia. They have a good paper but some issues to point:

1. Number of transplants and per hospital is not clear.
2. Success of transplantation is not clear.
3. The authors should add more detail to their results, number of surgeons performing transplantation, number of cases, mean hospital stay etc.

Reviewer: 4

Comments to the Author

The authors present a descriptive study/case series of kidney transplants performed in Indonesia, with the focus of their report being on 20 cases performed in Semarang, during the period 2014-2017. Some additional data from other Indonesian centres is also included (from personal correspondence rather than formal reporting, as well some data extracted from publications), though it is clear that there is a large amount of missing data (only 239 cases out of 623 have data reported). The vast majority of transplantation in Indonesia occurs in Jakarta; Semarang is a relatively small setting that is becoming established as a centre.

Is there an Indonesian renal registry? If so, have data from there been utilised? Are the authors reporting their outcomes to the registry?

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Comments:

The title should reflect that this is largely a report from Semarang, rather than Indonesia as a whole.

Abstract: There is no abstract included in the manuscript. Moreover, the abstract should be a summary of the paper, so the main manuscript needs to include everything in the abstract, with a greater level of detail.

Introduction: What was the aim of the study? Is it to primarily report on transplantation in Semarang? This needs to be clearer.

Some background on the nature of transplantation in Semarang including selection. criteria, immunosuppression used and referral sources for donors/recipients, follow-up arrangements should be included if this is the focus of the report (some of this could be under methods if appropriate)

Methods: This section is too brief and needs a lot more detail.

e.g. What baseline characteristics and outcomes will be reported? How was specific information obtained (review of clinical records/other etc etc).

There was a large amount of missing data - what the approach to including/excluding patient data for this study? How complete is the dataset? What data/centres/patients are missing?

Results:

Please state how many transplants overall and what data are reported (as in the abstract) over what time period (for Indonesian data)

Several tables and a figure are included after the manuscript but are not referred to in the text - please introduce them/cite them in the relevant sections. The tables contain most of the useful data; the text should summarise these (but not just duplicate it)

What are these results in para 1 referring to? The cases at Semarang, or from around Indonesia? Please make this clearer. More info on these are needed (numbers, why data missing). Are you referring here to the Figure?

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There is very little outcome data other than mortality. What about graft survival? rejection? complications? For a case series one would expect a much greater level of granular detail to be available.

The text needs to be explicit in the comparisons between Semarang and other Indonesian centres.

Do you have the ability to generate survival curves for Indonesian patients? Is there any improvement in outcomes over time?

Discussion - this section is too long and contains irrelevant material. The focus of the discussion should be on considering the results of the study, including any strengths/limitations, and the directly relevant context. Information about the context/challenges to transplant in Indonesia should be much more concise. Section 4.4 is the most relevant part of the discussion.

What does their paper add to the literature? The discussion is where the authors have a chance to establish this. It would be appropriate to include comparisons with other published reports from Indonesia (e.g. from the registry) in the discussion.

Conclusions - these should directly relate to the data the authors have presented and their interpretation of it, not be generic statements about transplantation in Indonesia.
